

TUITION POLICY

Rupert's Karate Academy is a martial arts studio that does not require its members to sign long contracts or enrollment agreements; however, martial arts training is a pursuit steeped in discipline and commitment and is not akin to a hobby or sport. Commitment and respect are mutual requirements from teacher to student.

Upon enrollment, you are responsible for attending the appropriate amount of classes based on your plan (either once a week or twice a week/unlimited). If you miss a class, or if class is cancelled for a Soo Bahk Do event, or the YMCA is closed in observance of a national holiday, it is your responsibility to make up the classes missed. Classes are held six days a week with many different options from which to choose, making it very easy to make up missed classes. Tuition will NOT be prorated or adjusted based on attendance under any circumstances.

Tuition invoices will be sent via email between the second and third weekends of each month, and you may pay at any time before the end of the month.

If for any reason you wish to discontinue training for one month at a time or more (or indefinitely), you **MUST** notify Mr. Rupert no less than **30 DAYS** in advance to cancel the invoice for the month. This is not only to maintain clear and accurate billing and accounting systems for your account, but as a courtesy to Mr. Rupert for services rendered and for planning classes accordingly for students anticipated to be in attendance, planning for testing, events, etc. Failure to notify with 30 Days' notice will require payment for the month.
